

NANO UV Scanner FAQ

Is the NANO UV Scanner safe to use?

The NANO is completely safe to use as long as the safety protocols outlined below are observed during use:

- * Keep the device away from children, and avoid exposure directly onto human skin.
- * Do not use the NANO on any part of the body.
- * Do not look directly into the UV light.
- * Do not touch the NANO UV lamp.
- * Keep the NANO UV Scanner out of reach of children.
- * Never disassemble the NANO UV Scanner.
- * Do not open, expose, modify, or touch the internal circuitry of the NANO as this can lead to high voltage shock.
- * Take care not to damage or break the UV lamp. Doing so poses a mercury hazard.

How long will my NANO UV Scanner last?

The NANO operates on 2 AAA batteries, and is backed by a 90 day limited warranty. The UV bulb has an expected life of 4,000 hours which translates to thousands of scans. The battery operated unit will require battery replacement typically after 400 scans. The quality of the battery used also affects the number of scans available but will continue to operate effectively as long as the NANO is not damaged or abused.

What is the "kill zone" of the NANO Scanner?

The kill zone is the length of the UV bulb. Although the scale of the bulb is designed specifically to be lightweight, compact, and portable without using a plug in adapter, this may mean more scans depending on the surface area to be disinfected. However the bulb is highly efficient in scanning and destroying germs in the targeted area.

Why does the NANO have a 10 second timer?

The timer is installed primarily for safety purposes, and ease in timing scanning segments. All laboratory testing protocols were done in 10 second scanning segments to determine the effectiveness of the kill zone, and proven to be the effective rate for sanitation.

How often should the NANO be used?

It's really dependent on personal desire and how frequently you need sanitary surfaces and tools, especially when using makeup, brushes, and tools on multiple clients. At minimum you should be doing scans of materials used frequently and/or in-between makeup applications. Because the NANO Scanner is portable, fast and efficient in sanitation it will fit easily into your makeup routine.

The NANO works fabulously to sanitize any surface or material that comes in human contact any time or place, whether at home, on the job, or traveling!

What kind of warranty does the NANO UV Scanner have?

The NANO is backed by a 90 day limited warranty.
